Weaver of stories, teacher of legends, and keeper of traditions, Lac du Flambeau Chippewa singer-songwriter Bobby Bullet will perform at the Crossroads Coffeehouse at 2020 Main Street in Cross Plains on Friday, July 20th at 7:00 p.m.



In 2010 Bobby Bullet was presented with the Lifetime Achievement Award by the Native American Music Industry (NAMI). In the same year Bobby's CD "Scrapbook" was nominated for a NAMI award in eight categories. Bobby's work on his most recent CD "Bigfoot" was rewarded by the NAMI Association when he was named a finalist for the Artist of the year in 2011. The title track: "Bigfoot" was also nominated for Best Pop Song of the Year in 2011. Both CDs will be available for purchase at the concert.

Performing solo with his guitar, audiences have come to expect an accessible style and a good laugh. Drawing on diverse musical influences from country, blues, jazz and rock, Bobby developed a form of Country-Folk music uniquely his own--over fifty years of writing and performing has grounded his music in personal experience and cultural history. His songs tell well-crafted stories that heal, teach and bridge his Native American roots to all peoples.
